



PALAIS STUTTERHEIM

The building, constructed between 1728 - 1730, was designed by Wenzel Perner for district administrator Christian Hieronymus von Stutterheim, and used as a Town Hall between 1836 - 1971. Today, the magnificent palace is home to the City Library and the Kunstpalais (Palace of Art), housing the Municipal Collections. The Bürgersaal (Citizens' Hall) and inner courtyard can be rented for events. Stage your event in an impressive historical building at the heart of Erlangen city centre!
