With about 3.3 million annual passengers, roughly 50 nonstop connections to many destinations in Europe and Northern Africa and connecting flights to more than 300 other destinations worldwide, the airport has been a gate to the world for the metropolitan region of Nuremberg for 60 years.

The airport bears the name of Nuremberg's most famous son: Albrecht Dürer (1471-1528) was a traveller, pioneer, visionary and trendsetter. He was attached to his home region and cosmopolitan at the same time.

FROM THE AIRPORT ON SHORT TRACK TO ERLANGEN

By car: Starting from "Flughafenstraße" turn right into "Marienbergstraße" and follow this road until "Erlanger Straße / B4", where you turn right again. Follow the B4 for about 15 km till you reach the city center of Erlangen.

By train: Take the underground line U2 in direction "Röthenbach" till you reach the main train station Nuremberg. From here you take the regional train R2 in the direction of "Lichtenfels" or the "S-Bahn" train in the direction of "Bamberg". After a total time of approximately 50 minutes you will reach the main train station in Erlangen.

By bus: Take the bus no. 33 and change buses at the stop "Am Wegfeld" to bus no. 30 in the direction of "Erlangen Hugenottenplatz". This bus is taking you directly to the city center. The total time by bus is about 40 minutes.
